The successful applicant will lead a small team supporting gender equality initiatives in the Pacific region and Fiji. The position provides management and performance oversight of Australia's gender equality investments in the Pacific region and Fiji. The position will support the transition of Pacific Women Shaping Pacific Development (Pacific Women) to a new regional gender equality investment program by working closely with key regional partners, including the Pacific Community (SPC) and the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat (PIFS). The successful applicant will also provide expert advice on gender equality and supporting the mainstreaming of gender equality objectives into all Australian aid programs regionally and within Fiji.
