The suitable candidate will have significant experience and sound understanding of private sector development and Fiji's economic context. The person will have highly developed written and oral communication skills and the ability to communicate effectively and professionally.

Under limited direction, the Manager will be responsible for implementing a new Australian aid program known as the Business Partnerships Platform (BPP). Under the BPP, the Australian Government will create innovative partnerships with Fiji's private sector to achieve positive social, environmental and economic impacts for Fiji.
